Equipment: Athletes use their own clothing and footwear (cleated shoes

or trail running shoes are recommended). Wearing glasses or contact lenses is at your own risk. The game ball will be

provided by the organizer ().

Venue: Venue and times will be announced in time by the

Organizing Committee.

Team: 3 field players + 1 substitute

General conditions of play:

2 winning sets per match

- Set to 15 points with a minimum 2 point lead (Third winning set first to 15 points)
- The ball may touch any part of the body.

This is considered as a contact

- First contact for receiving has to be a underarm pass (bump) or with two closed hands above the head; a regular overhead pass is not allowed
- The block isn't counting as one of the three contacts for a play
- * MAKKABI Germany, as the organizer, reserves the right to adapt the net height to local conditions (e.g. snow conditions) in deviation from the international regulations.

The referee court takes the international set of rules (CEV Rules) as a basis for the execution and decision making and in case of protest.





Competition guide

Preliminaries

The preliminary rounds will be played in round robin mode. A win scores 2 points, a draw scores 1 point, a loss scores 0 points. If there is a tie after the preliminary round, the point difference from the matches will decide the ranking.

Finals

The results from the preliminary round will be assigned to corresponding final matches depending on the number of teams (tournament tree of 4, 8 or 16 teams).
